

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER RESETTING MISDEMEANOR DISPOSITION  
DOCKET NOW SCHEDULED FOR MARCH 19, 2020, TO MAY 28, 2020**

On March 12, 2020, the World Health Organization designated the COVID-19 outbreak as a global pandemic. On March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared a national emergency as a result of the emerging public health threat posed by COVID-19. On March 15, 2020, the Governor of Oklahoma issued an Executive Order declaring an emergency in all 77 Oklahoma Counties caused by the impending threat of the COVID-19 to the health of the people of Oklahoma. On March 16, 2020, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma and the Presiding Judge of the Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals issued SCAD Order 2020-24 regarding rescheduling of cases due to the COVID-19 health crisis. In addition, the Oklahoma Department of Health has urged all Oklahomans to take steps to reduce the spread of infection.

Accordingly, the undersigned hereby orders that the **Misdemeanor Disposition Docket now scheduled for March 19, 2020, be rescheduled to May 28, 2020, at 9:00 a.m.**
