ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

On March 12, 2020, the World Health Organization designated the COVID-19 outbreak as a global pandemic. On March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared a national emergency as a result of the emerging public health threat posed by COVID-19. On March 15, 2020, the Governor of Oklahoma issued an executive order declaring an emergency in all 77 Oklahoma Counties caused by the impending threat of the COVID-19 to the people of Oklahoma. On March 16, 2020, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma and the Presiding Judge of the Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals issued SCAD Order 2020-24 regarding the rescheduling of certain pending cases due to the current COVID-19 health crisis. In addition, the Oklahoma Department of Health has urged all Oklahomans to take steps to reduce the spread of infection.

To protect the health and safety of litigants, witnesses and officers of the court, the undersigned hereby cancels all preliminary hearings now scheduled in the District Court of Bryan County from March 18, 2020, until April 9, 2020. Any party affected by this Order should contact one of the Court's bailiffs to select a new hearing date.
