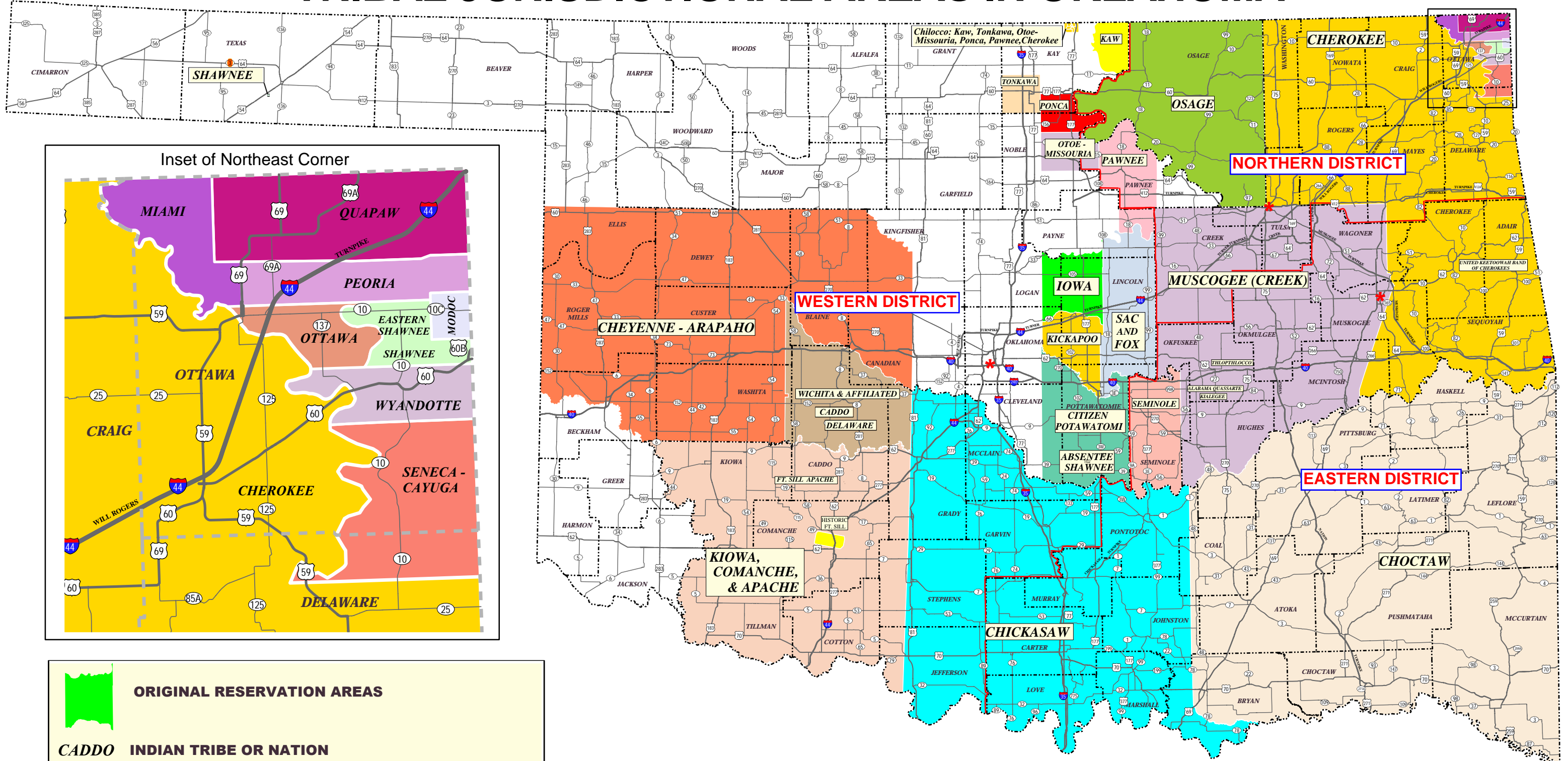


TRIBAL JURISDICTIONAL AREAS IN OKLAHOMA

INDIAN COUNTRY PARCELS SUBJECT TO FEDERAL & TRIBAL JURISDICTION MAY BE FOUND WITHIN THE COLORED REGIONS
 (Unless tribal reservation boundaries are intact, each parcel must independently qualify as Indian country for federal and tribal jurisdiction to exist)

Indian Country as defined by 18 U.S.C. Section 1151 (a), (b) & (c) -
 (a) formal [recognized treaty boundaries] & informal [tribal trust lands] reservations (including rights-of-way/roads running through the same), (b) dependent Indian communities, & (c) Indian allotments held in trust or restricted status (including rights-of-way/roads running through the same).
